- Feeling of not being wanted
- Not understanding British values
- Lack of confidence about own faith/
world view.

Signs to be aware of

- Increased time discussing extremist
issues
- Changing dress or appearance to fit
in with an extremist group
- Spending time on extremist causes
- Possession of objects/ symbols
attached to extremist causes
- Attempts to recruit others to
extremist causes
